MULTI-AGENCY COMMAND VEHICLE



MISSION // Coweta County, Georgia is a fast-growing suburb of the metro Atlanta area. The county's Emergency Management Agency needed a versatile command vehicle capable of regional deployment to support multi-agency responses during major incidents and planned events. Additionally, the vehicle would serve as a mobile backup for the county's 911 Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP), ensuring uninterrupted communication in emergencies.

SOLUTION // Nomad GCS designed, manufactured, and integrated a custom 34-foot Multi-Agency Command Vehicle with four flat-floor slideouts, designed to comfortably accommodate large response teams during incidents. The vehicle is fully automated with Nomad Total Command™ (NTC), allowing one person to easily manage key functions like vehicle leveling, slideout operation, and extending the 42-foot mast. For added functionality, it includes three exterior workstations and multiple interior conference and work areas, all equipped with advanced audiovisual and communication technologies. Additionally, built-in interfaces ensure the vehicle can serve as a full backup for the county's 911 PSAP operations, if needed.
