VA-HPO needed Mobile Medical Units to provide much-needed mental and physical health services to homeless Veteran populations in the field.

SOLUTION // Nomad GCS designed, manufactured, and integrated these fifteen Mobile Medical Units for the VA Homeless Programs Office. Mercedes-Benz Sprinter chassis were upfitted with exam tables and medical equipment, and wheelchair lifts were incorporated for full patient accessibility. With workstations, refrigerated storage, onboard engine-driven generators, and exterior awnings, these 15 units provide vital mental and physical health services to homeless Veterans, supporting their journey to comprehensive care.
