

MISSION // The Wisconsin Department of Corrections and Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development joined forces to implement a job training program for incarcerated persons. The program's goal is to provide training in mechatronics, resulting in marketable job skills in the outside workforce. A platform that could move between corrections facilities was needed for maximum program accessibility.

SOLUTION // Nomad GCS designed, manufactured, and integrated this custom 53-foot mobile training unit to support a joint mechatronics job training initiative. Featuring flat-floor slideouts, seated and standing-height lab stations, an instructor workstation, and project storage, the unit provides a fully equipped, ADA-accessible learning environment. The unit features rooftop HVAC, LED lighting, a wheelchair lift, and custom exterior graphics.
