The Wewoka IHS mandate to provide in-person patient care in often remote and underserved communities and rural areas demanded a dedicated mobile health solution.

**SOLUTION //** Nomad GCS designed, manufactured, and integrated this Mobile Medical Vehicle to provide remote care for Wewoka IHS patients. Equipped with two exam rooms, a patient wheelchair lift to facilitate accessible care, medical exam equipment, and a lavatory system, this vehicle enables comprehensive patient services. Built on a Freightliner M2 chassis, the thirty-foot medical clinic features an automatic leveling system and a reliable Powertech 12kW generator for extended operations.
