KRHV partnered with the Kalispell Regional Medical Center (KRMC) to develop specifications and fundraising initiatives to bring mobile mammography directly to those in need.

Outfitted with state-of-the-art imaging equipment, the unit ensures accessibility with a wheelchair lift and exterior staircase entry. Built on a Peterbilt 567 chassis, the 36' shelter features a slideout for added space, a reception area, dressing room, and exam room. Nomad Total Command™ (NTC) automation, onboard power, and climate control provide comfortable, reliable operation year-round.
